	Two or more parties may be joined as plaintiffs in a single action if their claims involve common
14	issues of fact and arise out of the same transaction or occurrence or series of transactions or
15	occurrences. On motion of any defendant, and a showing that joinder will not promote the ends of
16	justice nor the just and efficient conduct and disposition of the action, the court may order separate
17	trials on any or all of the issues and may require special interrogatories.

17 18 19 The plea of misjoinder is hereby abolished.
