5 6 7 WHEREAS, for the past five years, the Baldwin Intergenerational Program has paired at-risk students 8 from Baldwin Elementary School in Manassas with residents of the Prince William Senior Center, to the 9 benefit of the children, the senior citizens, and the Manassas community; and

10 WHEREAS, created by Ritchie Carroll of Baldwin Elementary and Kathy Lee-Meredith of the Senior Center, the program has resulted in academic, social, cultural, behavioral, and emotional improvement 11 12 for the children and feelings of satisfaction, joy, and accomplishment for the adults; and

WHEREAS, each year, the 15 students from the school who are "adopted" by 15 senior citizens from 13 14 the center meet with their mentors monthly, alternating between the school and the senior center; and

15 WHEREAS, the students learn from the knowledge and the accumulated life experiences of the 16 senior citizens, while the adults gain a sense of satisfaction and fulfillment from helping young people 17 succeed: and

18 WHEREAS, a singularly creative and innovative project, the Baldwin Intergenerational Program has been recognized by the Prince William Commission on Aging, the Manassas City Council, and the 19 20 Virginia and U.S. Departments of Education; and

21 WHEREAS, the initiative and continuing efforts of Ritchie Carroll and Kathy Lee-Meredith have 22 created a program of immediate and positive influence on the children, of immense gratification to the senior citizens, and of lasting benefit to the community and the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it 23

24 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly commend Ritchie Carroll and Kathy Lee-Meredith for their uniquely creative and effective efforts on 25 behalf of the schoolchildren and senior citizens of Manassas; and, be it 26

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare copies of this resolution 27 28 for presentation to Ritchie Carroll and Kathy Lee-Meredith as an expression of the General Assembly's 29 congratulations on the success of the Baldwin Intergenerational Program.
