5	(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate McClure)
6	Requesting the Transportation Coordinating Council of Northern Virginia to study regional
7	transportation planning in Northern Virginia.
8	WHEREAS, Northern Virginia is a growing area of the state with a substantial transportation
9	network; and
10	WHEREAS, businesses and persons traveling within the region cross county and city lines for their
11	private purposes and coordination among counties is necessary for the future economic prosperity of the
12 13	region; and WHEREAS, Fairfax County, Loudoun County, and Prince William County have become major
13 14	crossroads for people and goods traveling through this region; and
15	WHEREAS, there are several regional transportation planning bodies in Northern Virginia and in
16	some cases transportation proposals require the approval of as many as nine different transportation
17	organizations for certain transportation decisions; and
18	WHEREAS, movement between counties continues to increase and will increase more in the
19	foreseeable future; now, therefore, be it
20	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Transportation Coordinating
21	Council of Northern Virginia be requested to study regional transportation planning in Northern Virginia.
22	The Council is requested to consider the following:
23	1. Whether the functions of various transportation organizations should be consolidated into one
24 25	regional body; 2. What mechanisms should be used to manage coordination of transportation plans among the
2 6	various jurisdictions in Northern Virginia;
27	3. Whether any road or other transportation facilities that connect counties should be subject to the
28	approval of a regional transportation body;
29	4. Whether this regional transportation body should have representatives from the District of
30	Columbia, Maryland, and the federal government;
31	5. Whether such a body should facilitate the planning of rail, bus, and mass transportation in
32 33	Northern Virginia; 6. What federal, state, and local restrictions exist to hinder or facilitate establishment of such a
33 34	regional body;
35	7. What funding sources would be available or should be used by such regional transportation body;
36	and
37	8. Any other matter that the commission believes would facilitate regional transportation planning in
38	Northern Virginia.
39	The Council shall complete its work in time to submit its findings and recommendations to the
	Governor and the 1996 Session of the General Assembly as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for processing legislative documents.
