15	Amend the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article X a section numbered 8-A as follows:	
16	ARTICLE X	D
17	TAXATION AND FINANCE Section 8-A. Special funds.	•
18	The General Assembly shall not appropriate money from any special fund established by law for any	
19	purpose other than the purpose for which the fund was established except by a two-thirds vote of the	
20	members present in each house which two-thirds shall include a majority of the members elected to that	
21	house.	

If the General Assembly does so appropriate money from a special fund, it shall provide for
repayment of the money within two years from the date of the withdrawal of the money from the special
fund.
