1	HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 628
2	AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
3	(Proposed by the House Committee on Rules
4	on February 2, 1995)
5	(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Dillard)
6	Requesting the Board of Education and the State Council of Higher Education to study ways to relieve
7	critical teacher shortages.
8	WHEREAS, the Interim Report of the Governor's Commission on Champion Schools recognized that
9	there are continuing shortages of teachers in certain fields and in certain geographic areas, and there are
10	also shortages of males and minorities in the profession; and
11	WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Education has documented critical shortages in the licensure
12	areas of special education, science and mathematics, and selected foreign languages; and of minority
13	teachers and teachers for rural areas in all licensure areas; and
14	WHEREAS, the percentage of minority students in the public schools of Virginia is increasing at a
15	rapid rate while the percentage of minority teachers is decreasing; and
16	WHEREAS, the number of minority students preparing to teach is far below what would be needed
17	to replace the minorities who are retiring or resigning from teaching; and
18	WHEREAS, the cost of becoming a teacher has increased significantly in recent years; and
19	WHEREAS, funding for the Virginia Teaching Scholarship Loan program has been reduced gradually
20	from \$750,000 in 1987 to zero in the current biennium; now, therefore, be it
21	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Board of Education and the
22	State Council of Higher Education be requested to study ways to relieve critical teacher shortages The
23	Board and the Council, in collaboration with the Advisory Board on Teacher Education and Licensure,
24	are requested to identify ways to relieve teacher shortages in critical areas, including, but not limited to:
25	(i) approval of alternative routes to licensure for persons who change careers and for paraprofessionals;
26	(ii) reconstitution of the Virginia Teaching Scholarship Loan Program as a more effective and efficient
27	debt reduction program; (iii) dedication of financial aid for higher education that will lead to teacher
28	licensure; and (iv) high school programs to create interest among students in teaching careers, especially
29	in geographic and specialty shortage areas.
20	The Department of Education shall married staff summant for the study. All econories of the

30 The Department of Education shall provide staff support for the study. All agencies of the 31 Commonwealth shall provide assistance, upon request.

The Board of Education and the State Council of Higher Education shall submit their findings and recommendations to the Governor and the 1996 Session of the General Assembly as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents.
