LD5763749 1 **SENATE BILL NO. 709** 2 AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE 3 (Proposed by the House Committee on Finance 4 5 6 7 on February 20, 1995) (Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Waddell) A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.610 through 58.1-3650.620, designating certain organizations to be exempt from property taxation. 8 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 9 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.610 through 10 58.1-3650.620 as follows: 11 § 58.1-3650.610. Property of the Compass and Anchor Club. 12 A. The Compass and Anchor Club, a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a charitable organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia. 13 B. Property located in Loudoun County, owned by the Compass and Anchor Club and used by it 14 15 exclusively for charitable purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is 16 hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation. § 58.1-3650.611. Property of Wayside Foundation for the Arts, Inc. 17 18 A. The Wayside Foundation for the Arts, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the 19 20 Constitution of Virginia. 21 B. Property located in Frederick County, owned by the Wayside Foundation for the Arts, Inc., and 22 used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in 23 subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation. 24 § 58.1-3650.612. Property of the Fairfax County Symphony Orchestra, Inc. 25 A. The Fairfax County Symphony Orchestra, Inc., a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a cultural organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia. 26 27 B. Property located in Fairfax County, owned by the Fairfax County Symphony Orchestra, Inc., and 28 used by it exclusively for cultural purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this 29 section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation. 30 § 58.1-3650.613. Property of Bethany House of Northern Virginia, Inc. 31 A. Bethany House of Northern Virginia, Inc., a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the 32 33 Constitution of Virginia. 34 B. Property located in Fairfax County, owned by Bethany House of Northern Virginia, Inc., and used 35 by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A 36 of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation. 37 § 58.1-3650.614. Property of Fauquier Habitat for Humanity, Inc. 38 A. Fauquier Habitat for Humanity, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a 39 charitable organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia. 40 B. Property located in Fauguier County, owned by Fauguier Habitat for Humanity, Inc., and used by 41 it exclusively for charitable purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is 42 hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation. § 58.1-3650.615. Property of Park West Lions Club. 43 44 A. The Park West Lions Club, a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia. 45 B. Property located in Prince William County, owned by the Park West Lions Club and used by it 46 47 exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of **48** this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation. 49 § 58.1-3650.616. Property of Manassas Elks Lodge #2512. 50 A. The Manassas Elks Lodge #2512, a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a charitable 51 and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of 52 Virginia. 53 B. Property located in Prince William County, owned by the Manassas Elks Lodge #2512 and used 54 by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A 55 of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation. § 58.1-3650.617. Property of Guildfield Housing Development Corporation. 56 57 A. The Guildfield Housing Development Corporation, a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the 58 59 Constitution of Virginia.

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B. Property located in Pittsylvania County, owned by the Guildfield Housing Development 60 Corporation and used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as 61 62 set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation. 63

§ 58.1-3650.618. Property of Girls Incorporated, Center for Youth of Southwest Hampton Roads.

64 A. Girls Incorporated, Center for Youth of Southwest Hampton Roads, a nonprofit corporation, is 65 hereby designated as a charitable organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the 66 Constitution of Virginia.

B. Property located at 5815, 5851 and 5901 Portsmouth Boulevard in the City of Portsmouth, owned 67 by Girls Incorporated, Center for Youth of Southwest Hampton Roads and used by it exclusively for 68 charitable purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby 69 70 determined to be exempt from local taxation.

§ 58.1-3650.619. Property of the Peninsula Habitat for Humanity, Inc. 71

72 A. The Peninsula Habitat for Humanity, Inc., a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the 73 74 Constitution of Virginia.

75 B. Property located in the City of Newport News, owned by the Peninsula Habitat for Humanity, 76 Inc., and used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth 77 in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.

78 § 58.1-3650.620. Property of Al-Anon Family Group Headquarters, Inc.

A. Al-Anon Family Group Headquarters, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia. 79 80

B. Property located in the City of Virginia Beach, owned by Al-Anon Family Group Headquarters, 81 Inc. and used by it exclusively for benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A 82

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of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
