6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 8.01-40 of the Code of Virginia, relating to unauthorized use of name;
7	penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 8.01-40 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 8.01-40. Unauthorized use of name or picture of any person; exemplary damages; statute of
11	limitations.
12	A. Any person whose name, portrait, or picture is used for advertising purposes or for the purposes
13	of trade, without having first obtained the written consent of such person, or if dead, of the surviving
14	consort and if none, of the next of kin, or if a minor, the written consent of his or her parent or
15	guardian, for advertising purposes or for the purposes of trade, such persons may maintain a suit in
16	equity against the person, firm, or corporation so using such person's name, portrait, or picture to
17	prevent and restrain the use thereof; and may. The person may also sue and recover damages for any
18	injuries sustained by reason of such use- And, and if the defendant shall have knowingly used such
19	person's name, portrait or picture in such manner as is forbidden or declared to be unlawful by this
	chapter, the jury, in its discretion, may award exemplary damages. A prosecution may also be
20	
21	commenced pursuant to § 18.2-216.1.
22	B. A person who knowingly uses the name of any other person, without having first obtained the
23	written consent and authorization of the other person, in order to induce another to issue a credit card
24	may sue and recover damages for any injuries sustained thereby.

25 B. C. No action shall be commenced under this section subsection A more than twenty years after 26 the death of such person.
