A BILL to amend and reenact § 22.1-79.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to school calendars.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 22.1-79.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 22.1-79.1. School calendars; opening of the school year.

Each local school board shall set the school calendar *for the school division. Such calendar may be established* so that the first day students are required to attend school shall be after Labor Day. ~~The Board of Education may waive this requirement on a showing of good cause.~~
