11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 20-14 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 20-14. By whom license to be issued.
14	Every license for a marriage shall be issued by the clerk of the <i>a</i> circuit court of the <i>any</i> county; or
15	city in which the female or the male to be married usually resides, or his deputy [; and in case neither
16	the female nor the male is a resident of the Commonwealth, then by the clerk of any court authorized to
17	
	issue marriage licenses in this Commonwealth, or his deputy; or, if the office of the clerk be vacant ],
18	or if from any cause neither the clerk nor his deputy is able to issue the license, it may be issued by the
19	judge of the circuit court of such county, or city, who shall make return thereof to the clerk as soon as
20	there may be one.

21 2. That § 20-13.1 of the Code of Virginia is repealed.
