LD4855607 **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 329** 1 2 Senate Amendments in [] — February 7, 1995 3 Memorializing Congress to refrain from mandates dealing with air pollution control programs. 4 5 6 7 Patrons—Barry, Benedetti, Calhoun and Quayle; Delegates: Giesen, Hall, Mayer and Plum Referred to the Committee on Rules 8 9 WHEREAS, the Ozone Transport Commission (OTC) has recommended to the federal Environmental 10 Protection Agency (EPA) the imposition of a low-emission vehicle (LEV) program throughout the northeastern United States, including Northern Virginia, an action to which the General Assembly of 11 Virginia, in House Joint Resolution No. 1 of the 1994 Regular Session, has already expressed its 12 13 opposition; and 14 WHEREAS, use of subsidies, selective tax benefits, or other financial incentives are appropriate 15 means of encouraging the development of alternative fuel technologies and their accompanying 16 infrastructure and stimulating a market for alternative fuel vehicles; and WHEREAS, experience has disclosed a tendency for the Clean Air Act Amendments (CAAA), the 17 federal Energy Policy Act (EPACT), and EPA regulations to be used by the federal bureaucracy to 18 impose mandates upon the states without any consultation or consideration of state legislators or other 19 20 elected representatives of the people who will ultimately have to bear the financial and other costs of 21 these mandates: and 22 WHEREAS, the final decision on the appropriateness of such [subsidies mandates] as part of an air 23 pollution control and reduction program should be left in the hands of state legislators and other elected 24 representatives of affected people, and not be imposed by the federal bureaucracy; now, therefore, be it 25 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the Congress of the United States be hereby memorialized to refrain from imposing upon the states, through the medium of the 26 Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990, the Energy Policy Act of 1992, or federal regulations, any program 27 28 of mandates except after consultation with and the cooperation of the legislatures of the affected states; 29 and, be it 30 RESOLVED FURTHER. That the Clerk of the Senate transmit copies of this resolution to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the President of the United States Senate, and 31 the members of the Virginia congressional delegation in order that they may be apprised of the sense of

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the General Assembly in this matter.

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
