10 11	WHEREAS, Interstate Route 66 provides a critical transportation link for both intraregional and
11	interregional traffic in Virginia; and
13	WHEREAS, economic and population growth have contributed to increases in commuter and general
14	traffic during the past ten years along the Interstate Route 66 corridor in Fairfax, Prince William, and
15	Fauquier Counties; and
16	WHEREAS, the metropolitan planning regulations promulgated under the federal Intermodal Surface
17	Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) require a major investment study before any new transportation
18	facility can be built in air quality nonattainment area; and
19	WHEREAS, Senate Joint Resolution No. 104 of the 1994 Regular Session requested the Departments
20	of Transportation and Rails and Public Transportation to perform an alternative analysis study of new
21 22	bus, rail, and highway facilities along the Interstate Route 66 corridor; and WHEREAS, major investment studies are more comprehensive than alternatives analysis, and take
$\frac{22}{23}$	longer to complete; and
23 24	WHEREAS, it is desirable to perform the more rigorously analytical study; and
25	WHEREAS, the Department of Rail and Public Transportation is performing a major investment
26	study of new bus, rail, and highway facilities along the Interstate Route 66 corridor; now, therefore, be

30	report of their findings to the Governor and the 1996 Session of the General Assembly on the major
