CHAPTER 493

An Act to amend and reenact § 10.1-536 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the removal from office of a soil and water conservation district director.

Approved April 1, 1996

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 10.1-536 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 10.1-536. Removal from office.

Any district director may be removed by the Board ~~upon notice and hearing~~ for neglect of duty or malfeasance in office, or may be removed in accordance with the provisions of general law. *Upon receipt of a sworn complaint against a director filed by a majority of the directors of that same district, the Board shall (i) notify the district director that a complaint has been filed against him and (ii) hold a hearing to determine whether the district director's conduct constitutes neglect of duty or malfeasance in office.*
