An Act to amend and reenact § 4.1-322 of the Code of Virginia, relating to alcoholic beverage control; interdicted persons; penalty.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 4.1-322 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 4.1-322. Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages by interdicted persons; penalty.

No person who has been interdicted pursuant to §§ 4.1-333 and or § 4.1-334 shall possess any alcoholic beverages, except those acquired in accordance with subdivisions 1 through 5 of § 4.1-200, nor be drunk in public in violation of § 18.2-388. Any interdicted person found in possession of alcoholic beverages to be in violation of this section

Any interdicted person found in possession of alcoholic beverages to be in violation of this section shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
