9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 54.1-603 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 54.1-603. License required; requirements for licensure; nonresident applicants.
13	A. Unless exempted by § 54.1-601, no person or firm shall sell at auction without being licensed by
14	the Board. Any applicant for licensure who was certified by or registered with the Board prior to July 1,
15	1991, shall be exempt from the requirements of subsection B of this section if he applies prior to
16	January 1, 1992.
17	B. Any auctioneer desiring to obtain a license may apply to the Board and shall establish to the
18 19	satisfaction of the Board that he: 1. Is a resident of Virginia and meets the application fee requirements set by the Board;
<b>20</b>	2. Is covered by a surety bond, executed by a surety company authorized to do business in this
<b>20</b> <b>21</b>	Commonwealth, in a reasonable amount to be fixed by the Board, conditioned upon the faithful and
22	honest conduct of his business or employment;
23	3. Has successfully completed a course of study at a school of auctioneering which has obtained
24	course approval from the Board, or an equivalent course or conducted at least twenty-five auctions
25	within the past eight years at which the applicant has cried the bids; and
26	4. Has passed the quarterly Virginia Licensed Auctioneer's Examination, administered by the
27	Auctioneers Board.
28	C. A nonresident of the Commonwealth may be licensed as an auctioneer by meeting one of the
29 30	following requirements: (i) conform to the provisions of this Chapter and regulations of the Board with reference to resident auctioneers or (ii) hold a valid auctioneer's license or certificate in another state
30 31	with which reciprocity has been established by the Board. Nonresident applicants shall also file with the
32	Board an irrevocable consent that service of process upon the Director is as valid and binding as service
33	of process upon the applicant.
34	Any process or pleading served upon the Director shall be filed by the Director in his office and a
35	copy thereof immediately forwarded by registered mail to the main office of the auctioneer at the last
