11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-57.1:1 as follows:
12	§ 18.2-57.1:1. Disarming a law enforcement officer; penalty.
13	Any individual who knows or has reason to know a person is a law-enforcement officer and who,
14	while such officer is acting within the scope of his duties, (i) knowingly removes a firearm from the

15 possession of the officer or deprives the officer of the use of the firearm is guilty of a Class 4 felony, or (ii) knowingly removes a chemical irritant weapon, stun weapon or impact weapon from the possession of the officer or deprives the officer of the use of the weapon is guilty of a Class 5 felony. 16
