2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 18.2-266 of the Code of Virginia, relating to charging the offense of*  
3 *driving while intoxicated.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 18.2-266 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 18.2-266. Driving motor vehicle, engine, etc., while intoxicated, etc.

9 It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate any motor vehicle, engine or train (i) while  
10 such person has a blood alcohol concentration of 0.08 percent or more by weight by volume or 0.08  
11 grams or more per 210 liters of breath as indicated by a chemical test administered as provided in this  
12 article, (ii) while such person is under the influence of alcohol, (iii) while such person is under the  
13 influence of any narcotic drug or any other self-administered intoxicant or drug of whatsoever nature, or  
14 any combination of such drugs, to a degree which impairs his ability to drive or operate any motor  
15 vehicle, engine or train safely, or (iv) while such person is under the combined influence of alcohol and  
16 any drug or drugs to a degree which impairs his ability to drive or operate any motor vehicle, engine or  
17 train safely. *A charge alleging a violation of this section shall support a conviction under clauses (i),*  
18 *(ii), (iii) or (iv).*

19 For the purposes of this section, the term "motor vehicle" includes mopeds, while operated on the  
20 public highways of this Commonwealth.
