A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-742.1 of the Čode of Virginia, relating to special license plates for persons awarded the Bronze Star or the Silver Star; fee.

Patrons—Hargrove; Senator: Bolling

Referred to Committee on Transportation

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 46.2-742.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-742.1. Special license plates for persons awarded the Bronze Star or the Silver Star; fee.

On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded a Bronze Star or Silver Star Medal, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are issued.

The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.
