House Amendments in [] — January 31, 1996

A BILL to amend and reenact § 22.1-32 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the method for increasing school board salaries.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**1. That § 22.1-32 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

§ 22.1-32. Salary of members.

A. The school board of the following counties may pay each of its members an annual salary not to exceed the limits hereinafter set forth:

144 C. Any school board may in its discretion, after passage of an appropriate resolution by the
 145 governing body of the appropriate county, city or town, pay the chairman of the school board an
 146 additional salary not exceeding \$1,100 per year.

147 D. Any school board may in its discretion pay each of its members mileage for use of a private
 148 vehicle in attending meetings of the school board and in conducting other official business of the school
 149 board.

150 E. Contingent upon finalization of the planned consolidation of the school divisions of Alleghany
 151 County and the City of Clifton Forge, the members of the newly consolidated school board representing
 152 the City of Clifton Forge shall be paid an amount equal to that paid the members of the present school
 153 board of Alleghany County.

154 F. No school board, whose membership is elected in whole or in part, shall be awarded a salary
 155 increase unless, upon an affirmative vote by such school board, a specific salary increase shall be
 156 approved *as provided in this subsection. Every proposed [increase change] in the annual salary for*
 157 *members of local school boards shall be adopted by the school board at least four months prior to the*
 158 *date of the next school board election. The proposed [increase change] in the annual salary for school*
 159 *board members shall be included in the school board's annual budget submitted to the local governing*
 160 *body. No [increase change] in the annual salary for school board members shall take effect prior to*
 161 *the date of the next school board election. However, this restriction shall not apply to school boards*
 162 *whose members are elected for staggered terms.*
