VIRGINIA-ISRAEL ADVISORY BOARD.

- 246 § 9-350. Virginia-Israel Advisory Board established; purpose.
- The Virginia-Israel Advisory Board is hereby established and is hereafter referred to in this chapter 247 248 as the "Board". The purpose of the Board shall be to advise the Governor on ways to improve economic 249 and cultural links between the Commonwealth and the State of Israel, with a focus on the areas of 250 commerce and trade, art and education, and general government. 251
 - § 9-351. Membership; terms; vacancies; chairman.

The Board shall consist of twenty-five members to be appointed as follows: six citizen members 252 253 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates, who may be members of the House or other state 254 or local elected officials; six citizen members appointed by the Senate Committee on Privileges and 255 Elections, who may be members of the Senate or other state or local elected officials; thirteen members who represent business, industry, education, the arts, and government, appointed by the Governor. The 256 257 Secretaries of Commerce and Trade, and Education, or their designees shall serve as ex officio members 258 of the Board.

259 Citizen members shall serve for terms of four years. The Secretaries of Commerce and Trade, and 260 Education, or their designees, shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office. Vacancies 261 occurring other than by expiration of term shall be filled for the unexpired term. Any member may be 262 reappointed for successive terms.

- 263 The members of the Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman annually.
- 264 Members shall receive no compensation for their services.
- 265 § 9-352. Powers and duties of the Board.
- 266 The Board shall:

267 1. Undertake studies and gather information and data in order to accomplish its purposes as set 268 forth in § 9-350, and to formulate and present its recommendations to the Governor and the General 269 Assembly.

270 2. Apply for, accept, and expend gifts, grants, or donations from public, quasi-public or private 271 sources to enable it to better carry out its purposes.

- 272 3. Report annually its findings and recommendations to the Governor. The Board may make interim 273 reports to the Governor as it deems advisable.
- 274 § 9-353. Staff; cooperation from other state agencies.
- 275 The Office of the Governor shall serve as staff to the Board. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall 276 assist the Board upon request.
