12	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
13	1. That § 46.2-749.4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
14	§ 46.2-749.4. Special license plates bearing the seal, symbol, emblem, or logotype of certain
15 16	localities.
10	On receipt of a minimum of 1,000 350 paid applications therefor, the Commissioner may design and issue special license plates whose design incorporates the seal, symbol, emblem, or logotype of any
18	county or city.
19	The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars plus the
20	prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of 1,000
21	registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid to the locality whose seal, symbol,
22	emblem, or logotype appears on the plate. These funds shall be paid to the affected localities quarterly
23	and may be used as provided by the local governing body.
24	Nowithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, on the basis of an agreement entered into by
25	both the Department and a county or city, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed
26 27	cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of twenty-five dollars at the time the plates are issued for license plates bearing the seal symbol emblan or logotype of the county or city entering into the
27 28	license plates bearing the seal, symbol, emblem, or logotype of the county or city entering into the agreement.
