A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-373 of the Code of Virginia, relating to obscene items.

Patrons—Guest, Almand, Cunningham and Woodrum; Senator: Howell

Referred to Committee for Courts of Justice

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 18.2-373 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 18.2-373. Obscene items enumerated.

Obscene items shall include:

(1) Any obscene book; or

(2) Any obscene leaflet, pamphlet, magazine, booklet, picture, painting, bumper sticker, drawing, photograph, film, negative, slide, motion picture, videotape recording, *other writings*; or

(3) Any obscene figure, object, article, instrument, novelty device, or recording or transcription used or intended to be used in disseminating any obscene song, ballad, words, or sounds.
