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9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 15.1-486.4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 15.1-486.4. Uniform regulations for manufactured housing.
12	A. Counties, cities, and towns adopting and enforcing zoning ordinances under the provisions of this
13	article shall provide that, in all agricultural zoning districts or districts having similar classifications
14	regardless of name or designation where agricultural, horticultural, or forest uses such as but not limited
15	to those described in § 58.1-3230 are the dominant use, the placement of manufactured houses that are
16	nineteen or more feet in width, on a permanent foundation and on individual lots shall be permitted,
17	subject to development standards that are equivalent to those applicable to site-built single family
18	dwellings within the same or equivalent zoning district.
19	B. Counties, cities, and towns adopting and enforcing zoning regulations under the provisions of this
20	article may, to provide for the general purposes of zoning ordinances, adopt uniform standards, so long
21	as they apply to all residential structures erected within the agricultural zoning district or other districts
22	identified in subsection A of this section incorporating such standards. Such standards shall not have the
23	effect of excluding manufactured housing.
24	C. Local zoning ordinances adopting provisions consistent with this section shall not relieve lots or
25	parcels from the obligations relating to manufactured housing units imposed by the terms of a restrictive
26	covenant.

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
