Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That §§ 2.1-1.7 and 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Title 9 a chapter numbered 46, consisting of sections numbered 9-350 through 9-353, as follows:

§ 2.1-1.7. State councils.

## CHAPTER 46.

## VIRGINIA-ISRAEL PARTNERSHIP COUNCIL.

§ 9-350. Virginia-Israel Partnership Council established; purpose.

The Virginia-Israel Partnership Council is hereby established and is hereafter referred to in this chapter as the "Council". The purpose of the Council shall be to advise the Governor and the General Assembly on ways to improve economic and cultural links between the Commonwealth and the State of Israel, with a focus on the areas of commerce and trade, art and education, and general government.

§ 9-351. Membership; terms; vacancies; chairman.

The Council shall consist of twenty-five members to be appointed as follows: seven members to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates who may be members of the House of Delegates, or other state or local elected officials; six members appointed by the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections who may be members of the Senate, or other state or local elected officials; and twelve members who represent business, industry, education, the arts, and government, appointed by the Governor.

Citizen members shall serve for terms of four years. Legislative members shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office. Vacancies occurring other than by expiration of term shall be filled for the unexpired term. Any member may be reappointed for successive terms.

The members of the Council shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman annually. The Council shall

meet at least two times per year.

Legislative members of the Council shall be compensated as specified in § 14.1-18, and all other members shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses incurred by them in the performance of their

§ 9-352. Powers and duties of the Council.

The Council shall:

- 1. Undertake studies and gather information and data in order to accomplish its purposes as set forth in § 9-350, and to formulate and present its recommendations to the Governor.
- 2. Apply for, accept, and expend gifts, grants, or donations from private sources to enable it to better carry out its purposes.
- 226 3. Report annually its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly. The 227 Council may make interim reports to the Governor and the General Assembly as it deems advisable. 228

§ 9-353. Staff; cooperation from other state agencies.

The Department of Economic Development shall serve as staff to the Council. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall assist the Council upon request.
