Maiming, etc., of another resulting from driving while intoxicated. 13 Any person who, as a result of driving while intoxicated in violation of clause (ii), (iii) or (iv) of § 18.2-266, causes the severe injury of another person resulting in permanent and significant physical 14 impairment shall be guilty of a Class 6 felony. 15 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment in state 16 correctional facilities. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation 17 18 is \$375,000.
