2 3 4 5 6	House Amendments in [] — February 9, 1996 A BILL to amend and reenact §§ [ 3.04, ] 4.02 and 17.02, as amended, of Chapter 323 of the Acts of Assembly of 1950, which provided a charter for the City of Falls Church and to amend Chapter 323 by adding a section numbered 3.07, relating to [ school boards vacancies on city council and school board ], powers of the council and the planning commission.

12	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That §§ [ 3.04, ] 4.02 and 17.02, as amended, of Chapter 323 of the Acts of Assembly of 1950
13 14	are amended and reenacted and that Chapter 323 is amended by adding a section numbered 3.07
15	as follows:
16	[ <del>§ 3.07.</del> Vacancies in office of school board member.
17	When a vacancy occurs in the office of school board member, the remaining members, by majority
18	vote of all the remaining members, shall make an interim appointment to the office until the vacancy is
19	filled at the next regular May election. However, if the vacancy occurs within 120 days prior to such
20	election, the interim appointment shall be for the remainder of the term.
21	§ 3.04. When any vacancy shall occur in the membership of the office of councilman, from any
22	cause, and the term of the office wherein the vacancy exists shall continue for one year or more after
23	the next succeeding regular May election, the vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term by election
24	in the next regular May election, the candidate elected shall be installed in office immediately thereafter.
25	The Council may by a majority vote of all the remaining members, fill said vacancy until said election
26	is held.
27 28	Vacancies in office of member of city council. When a vacancy occurs in the office of member of the council, whatever the cause, the vacancy shall
20 29	be filled for the unexpired portion of the term by special election at the next May general election date,
30	as provided in § 24.2-226 of the Code of Virginia. The remaining members of the council shall make an
31	interim appointment to fill the vacancy, as provided in § 24.2-228 of the Code of Virginia.
32	§ 3.07. Vacancies in office of member of school board.
33	When a vacancy occurs in the office of member of the school board, the vacancy shall be filled in
34	the same manner in which vacancies are filled on the city council, as provided in § 3.04. The remaining
35	members of the school board shall make an interim appointment to fill the vacancy. ]
36	§ 4.02. Powers.
37 38	All powers vested in the city shall be exercised by the council except as otherwise provided in this charter. In addition to the foregoing, the council shall have the following powers:
30 39	(a) To establish goals and objectives and provide for the organization, conduct and operation of all
<b>40</b>	departments, bureaus, divisions, boards, commissions, offices and agencies of the city.
41	(b) To create, alter or abolish departments, bureaus, divisions, boards, commissions, offices and
42	agencies other than those specifically established by Chapters 10, 11, and 17 and 19, and §§ 16.06 and
43	20.02 of this charter.
44	(c) Upon recommendation of the city manager, to assign and reassign to departments, all bureaus,
45	divisions, offices, agencies, departments and functions thereof except the city school board.
46	(d) To provide for the number, titles, qualifications, powers, duties and compensation of all officers
47 48	and employees of the city, subject in the case of members of the classified service to the provisions of Chapter 9 of this charter.
40 49	(e) To provide for the form of oaths and the amount and condition of surety bonds to be required of
50	certain officers and employees of the city.
51	§ 17.02. City Planning Commission; composition; appointment, qualifications and removal of
52	members.
53	There shall be a city planning commission which shall consist of seven members appointed by the
54	Council- One member shall be a member of the Board of Zoning Appeals appointed for a term
55 5(	coincident with his term on such board; six citizen members who shall be qualified voters of the city,
56 57	actually residing within the city limits, who hold no office of profit under the city government,
57 58	appointed for terms of four years; provided, that the five citizen members in office on June 30, 1966, shall continue for the length of their appointed terms. A sixth citizen member shall be appointed to
59	serve from the first day of July 1, 1966, for a term expiring on the thirty-first day of December 31,

1968. Effective the first day of January 1, 1967, and every four years thereafter, three *four* citizen members shall be appointed, and effective the first day of January 1, 1969, and every four years thereafter, three citizen members shall be appointed. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the term. A member may be removed by the council for neglect of duty or malfeasance in office, upon written charges and after public hearing.
