§ *Î*1-41.2:2. Design-build or construction management contracts for public bodies other than the
 Commonwealth; eligibility requirements; award of contract; records to be kept.

A. While the competitive sealed bid process remains the preferred method of construction procurement for public bodies in the Commonwealth, any public body other than the Commonwealth may enter into a contract for construction on a fixed price or not-to-exceed price design-build or construction management basis provided the public body complies with the requirements of this section and has obtained the approval of the Design-Build/Construction Management Review Board (the Review Board) pursuant to § 11-41.2:5. Prior to issuing a Request for Proposal for any design-build or construction management contract for a specific construction project, the public body shall:

288 1. Have adopted, by ordinance or resolution, written procedures governing the selection, evaluation 289 and award of design-build and construction management contracts. Such procedures shall be consistent 290 with those described in this chapter for the procurement of nonprofessional services through competitive 291 negotiation. Such procedures shall also require requests for proposals to include and define the criteria 292 of such construction project in areas such as site plans, floor plans, exterior elevations, basic building 293 envelope materials, fire protection information plans, structural, mechanical (HVAC), electrical systems, 294 and special telecommunications and may define such other requirements as the public body determines 295 appropriate for that particular construction project:

a. Such procedures for design-build construction projects shall include a two-step competitive
negotiation process consistent with the applicable provisions of the Design-Build Selection Procedures of
paragraph D of Chapter IX (Special Construction Procedures) of the Capital Outlay Manual of the
Commonwealth developed by the Department of General Services through the Division of Engineering
and Buildings. The provisions of the Capital Outlay Manual shall apply, mutatis mutandis, to such
procedures for design-build construction projects.

b. Such procedures for construction management projects shall include (i) selection procedures
consistent with the applicable provisions of the Selection Procedures of paragraph E of Chapter IX
(Special Construction Procedures) of the Capital Outlay Manual of the Commonwealth and (ii) required
construction management contract terms consistent with applicable provisions of the Required

306 Construction Management Contract Terms of paragraph F of Chapter IX (Special Construction 307 Procedures) of the Capital Outlay Manual. The provisions of the Capital Outlay Manual shall apply, 308 mutatis mutandis, to such procedures for construction management projects.

309 2. Have in its employ or under contract a licensed architect or engineer who shall possess the 310 requisite ability and competence appropriate for such construction project; and

311 3. Have documented in writing that for a specific construction project (i) a design-build or 312 construction management contract is more advantageous than a competitive sealed bid construction contract; (ii) there is a benefit to the public body by using a design-build or construction management 313 314 contract; and (iii) competitive sealed bidding is not practical or fiscally advantageous.

B. Once approved by the Review Board in accordance with § 11-41.2:5, the public body may award 315 a design-build or construction management contract. Unless otherwise specified in the Request for 316 Proposal, such contract shall be awarded to the fully qualified offeror who submits an acceptable 317 318 proposal at the lowest cost in response to the Request for Proposal.

319 C. The public body shall provide information as requested by the Review Board to allow post-project 320 evaluation by the Review Board.

321 § 11-41.2:3. Design-Build/Construction Management Review Board created; membership; terms; 322 staffing: seal.

323 A. There is hereby created the Design-Build/Construction Management Review Board, hereinafter 324 referred to as the Review Board, which shall be composed of nine members to be appointed by the 325 Governor as follows: the Director of the Division of Engineering and Buildings of the Department of 326 General Services, or his designee; two Class A general contractors selected from a list recommended by 327 the Associated General Contractors; two design professionals selected from a list recommended by the Consulting Engineers Council of Virginia, the Virginia Society of the American Institute of Architects, 328 and the Virginia Society of Professional Engineers; and four representatives of public bodies other than 329 330 the Commonwealth selected from a list recommended by the Virginia Municipal League and the Virginia Association of Counties. The Director of the Division of Engineering and Buildings or his designee shall 331 332 be a nonvoting member of the Review Board, except in the event of a tie vote of the Review Board.

333 B. The initial terms of the Review Board shall be as follows: three members shall be appointed for 334 two-year terms, three members shall be appointed for three-year terms and three members shall be 335 appointed for four-year terms. Thereafter, all appointments shall be for terms of four years, except that 336 appointments to fill vacancies shall be for the unexpired terms. No person shall be eligible to serve for 337 more than two successive full terms, except the Director of the Division of Engineering and Buildings, 338 who shall serve until a successor qualifies.

339 C. The Review Board shall elect its chairman and vice-chairman from among its members. Members 340 shall receive no compensation for their services as members of the Review Board, but the 341 nongovernmental members shall receive reasonable expenses.

D. The Review Board shall meet monthly to conduct its business as required by § 11-41.2:4. 342 However, monthly meetings may be canceled by the chairman if here is no business before the Review 343 344 Board. Five members shall constitute a quorum.

345 E. Such staff support as is necessary for the conduct of the Review Board's business shall be 346 furnished by the Division of Engineering and Buildings of the Department of General Services pursuant 347 to § 2.1-483.1:2.

348 F. The Review Board shall adopt a seal by which it shall authenticate its proceedings. 349

§ 11-41.2:4. Duties of the Design-Build/Construction Management Review Board.

350 The Review Board shall have the following duties:

351 1. Review submissions by public bodies other than the Commonwealth of draft or adopted ordinances 352 or resolutions to determine if the process for the selection, evaluation and award of a design-build or 353 construction management contract is in compliance with the provisions of \S 11-41.2:2;

354 2. Review the findings and the basis of such findings submitted by the public body to determine if the 355 public body has complied with the requirements of § 11-41.2:2 and that the findings made by the public 356 body pursuant to § 11-41.2:2 are reasonable;

357 3. Adopt regulations in accordance with the Administrative Process Act (§ 9-6.14:1 et seq.) relating 358 to the form and substance of submissions to be reviewed by the Review Board;

359 4. Make post-project evaluations of construction projects procured by design-build or construction 360 management contracts entered into by public bodies other than the Commonwealth, including cost and time savings, effectiveness of the selection, evaluation and award of such contracts, and the benefit to 361 362 the public body; and

363 5. Report to the General Assembly and the Governor on or before December 1, 1999, concerning the 364 Review Board's evaluation of and findings regarding all design-build and construction management 365 construction undertaken by public bodies other than the Commonwealth since July 1, 1996, and any recommendations relating to future use of design-build or construction management contracts by such 366 367 public bodies.

368 § 11-41.2:5. Review by the Review Board for design-build or construction management approval;
 369 effect of disapproval; review of Review Board decision.

The Review Board shall conduct such inquiry it deems appropriate and may require the submission
of additional documents or information by the public body, in a form prescribed by the Review Board,
to determine if the public body has complied with the provisions of this chapter.

373 Within sixty working days of the receipt of the request for review, the Review Board shall render a 374 decision, unless a different timetable is agreed to by the public body. If the Review Board determines that the public body has complied with the provisions of § 11-41.2:2 and its findings are not 375 376 unreasonable, it shall approve such use. If the Review Board determines that the public body has not 377 complied with the provisions of § 11-41.2.2, it shall disapprove such use, and the public body shall not 378 use a design-build or construction management contract to procure construction for the proposed 379 project. If no decision is made by the Review Board within the sixty-day period or as otherwise agreed 380 to by the public body, the proposed use of a design-build or construction management contract shall be 381 deemed approved.

382 Any public body other than the Commonwealth which has been aggrieved by any action of the
383 Review Board shall be entitled to a review of such action. Appeals from such actions shall be in
384 accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Process Act (§ 9-6.14:1 et seq.).

385 2. That the provisions of §§ 11-41.2:2 through 11-41.2:5 shall not apply to any project authorized 386 pursuant to § 11-41.2:1 on or before July 1, 1996, except to the extent such provisions relate to 387 post-project evaluations by the Review Board.

388 3. That § 11-41.2:1 of the Code of Virginia is repealed, effective January 1, 1997.

389 4. That the authority granted to public bodies other than the Commonwealth pursuant to

390 § 11-41.2:1 for projects listed therein shall continue notwithstanding the repeal of § 11-41.2:1 on 391 January 1, 1997.

392 5. That on or before July 1, 1997, the Review Board shall adopt regulations, based on the

393 substantive requirements of Chapter IX of the Capital Outlay Manual of the Commonwealth, for a 394 two-step competitive negotiation process which shall be applied to design-build and construction

394 two-step competitive negotiation process which shall be applied to design-build and construction 395 management projects undertaken by public bodies other than the Commonwealth. Such

396 regulations, upon final adoption, shall supersede the provisions of subsection A 1a and A 1b of

397 § **11-41.2:2** of this act.
