9	Whereas, the Military Order of the Purple Heart of the USA in the Commonwealth of Virginia
10	desires to promote the principles and objectives of patriotism, fraternalism, history, and education among
11	the peoples of the Commonwealth; and
12	Whereas, these principles and objectives of the Order can be expressed through perpetuating the
13	ideals and heritage fostered by George Washington, who, as the general commanding the Military Forces
14 15	of America during the War of the Revolution, established and awarded the Purple Heart decoration; and Whereas, General George Washington's birthplace in Westmoreland County, Virginia, has been
16	designated a National Monument; and
17	Whereas; Ferry Farm, General George Washington's boyhood home in Stafford County, Virginia, has
18	been recognized by federal and state authorities as a national historical site; and
19	Whereas, General George Washington's home at Mount Vernon in Fairfax County, Virginia, the
20	place where the General is entombed, is considered a national shrine; and
21	Whereas, it has long been a practice to honor national heroes and patriots by naming national and
22	state landmarks for them; and
23	Whereas; there is an opportunity for the citizens of Virginia thus to honor both living and deceased
24	combat-wounded veterans who are recipients of the Purple Heart Medal, an award established by
25	General George Washington on August 7, 1782, at Newburgh-on-the-Hudson, following his victory over
26	British forces at the Battle of Yorktown; now, therefore
27	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
28	1. § 1. The portion of Virginia Route 3 from George Washington's Birthplace National Monument in
29 30	Westmoreland County, Virginia, to the junction of Virginia Route 3 with Interstate Route 95 at
30 31	Fredericksburg, Virginia, and the entire length of Interstate Highway 95 in Virginia are hereby designated as the Purple Heart Trail, in honor of General George Washington and the combat-wounded
31 32	veterans awarded the Purple Heart Medal. The Department of Transportation shall place and maintain
32 33	appropriate markers indicating the designation of this route.
