9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
	1. That § 36-98 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11 12 13	§ 36-98. Board to promulgate Statewide Code; other codes and regulations superseded; exceptions. A. The Board is hereby directed and empowered to adopt and promulgate a Uniform Statewide
14 15	Building Code. Such building code Building Code shall supersede the building codes and regulations of the counties, municipalities and other political subdivisions and state agencies. However, such Code shall
16	not supersede the regulations of other state agencies which require and govern the functional design and
17 18	operation of building related activities not covered by the Uniform Statewide Building Code including but not limited to: (1) public water supply systems, (2) waste water treatment and disposal systems, and
19	(3) solid waste facilities. Nor shall state agencies be prevented from requiring, pursuant to other state
20 21	law, that buildings and equipment be maintained in accordance with provisions of the Uniform Statewide Building Code.
22 23	B. As part of the Uniform Statewide Building Code, the Board shall adopt a construction code for the renovation of existing buildings. Such code shall be administered, at the option of the owner and
24	upon payment of a fee as determined by the Board, in lieu of Code provisions applicable to new
25	construction. However, the repair or replacement of plumbing, electrical and mechanical systems shall

26 be subject to Code provisions governing new construction. The construction code may include an
27 inventory of past building codes to assist owners of such buildings in the preservation of the historical
28 integrity of the building.

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
