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## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-335 of the Code of Virginia, relating to learner's permits.

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## Approved

#### 5 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

### 1. That § 46.2-335 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 7

§ 46.2-335. Learner's permits; fees.

8 A. The Department, on receiving from any Virginia resident over the age of fifteen years, an 9 application for a learner's permit may, subject to the applicant's successful completion of the written or 10 automated knowledge and vision examinations, issue a permit entitling the applicant, while having the permit in his immediate possession, to drive a motor vehicle on the highways, when accompanied by a 11 12 licensed driver eighteen twenty-one years of age or older or by his parent, legal guardian, or by a 13 brother, sister, half-brother, half-sister, step-brother, or step-sister eighteen years of age or older who is (i) actually occupying a seat beside the driver and (ii) lawfully permitted to operate a motor vehicle at 14 15 that time. Such permit shall be valid until he either is issued a driver's license as provided for in this chapter or no longer meets the qualifications for issuance of a learner's permit as provided in this 16 17 section. For persons qualifying for a driver's license through driver education courses approved by the 18 Department of Education or courses offered by commercial driver training schools licensed by the 19 Department, the application for the learner's permit shall be used as the application for the driver's license. Driver's licenses shall be issued by the Department to persons successfully completing driver 20 education courses approved by the Department of Education when the Department receives from the 21 school proper certification that the student (i) has successfully completed such course, including a road 22 23 skills examination and (ii) is in good academic standing and (iii) upon payment of a fee of \$2.40 per 24 year, based on the period of the license's validity. The provisions of §§ 46.2-323 and 46.2-334 relating 25 to evidence and certification of Virginia residence shall apply, mutatis mutandis, to learner's permits 26 issued under this section. The application for a learner's permit shall not be granted without evidence of 27 compliance with Article 1 (§ 22.1-254 et seq.) of Chapter 14 of Title 22.1, submitted on a form furnished by the Board of Education and certified by the division superintendent or any of his designees, 28 29 the nonpublic school principal or any of his designees, or the home schooling parent or tutor, or 30 presentation of a high school diploma or its equivalent or a certificate indicating completion of a 31 prescribed course of study as defined by the local school board pursuant to § 22.1-253.13:4. The 32 Department shall charge a fee of three dollars for each learner's permit issued under this section, which 33 shall be paid into the driver education fund of the state treasury. It shall be unlawful for any person, after having received a learner's permit, to drive a motor vehicle without being accompanied by a 34 35 licensed driver as provided in the foregoing provisions of this section. Violation of this section shall constitute a Class 2 misdemeanor. Nothing in this section shall be construed to permit the issuance of a 36 37 learner's permit entitling a person to drive a commercial motor vehicle, except as provided by the 38 Virginia Ĉommercial Driver's License Act (§ 46.2-341.1 et seq.).

39 B. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Department shall not issue a 40 learner's permit to any applicant under the age of fifteen years, six months unless the applicant is in 41 good academic standing. For applicants attending public schools, good academic standing may be 42 certified by the public school principal or any of his designees. For applicants attending nonpublic schools, such certification shall be made by the private school principal or any of his designees; for 43 44 minors receiving home schooling, such certification shall be made by the home schooling parent or 45 tutor.

46 B. C. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Department shall not issue 47 a learner's permit with a classification entitling the permittee to drive motorcycles unless:

48 1. The person is receiving instructions from a qualified instructor in a course approved by the 49 Department; 50

2. The person has successfully completed the off-street portion of the course;

3. When the instruction is conducted on the public highways, it follows a prescribed course which 51 52 has been approved by the chief local law-enforcement official;

53 4. The persons receiving the instruction, or the motorcycles used in the instruction, are clearly 54 marked "STUDENT DRIVER":

55 5. The person is under the supervision of his instructor at all times; and

56 6. No person, except the person receiving the instruction, occupies the motorcycle while instruction is 57 being given.
