10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 18.2-56.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 18.2-56.2. Allowing access to firearms by children; penalty.
13	A. It shall be unlawful for any person to recklessly leave a loaded, unsecured firearm in such a
14	manner as to endanger the life or limb of any child under the age of fourteen. Any person violating the
15	provisions of this subsection shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor.

	B. It shall be unlawful for any person knowingly to authorize a child under the age of twelve
17	<i>fourteen</i> to use a firearm except when the child is under the supervision of an adult. Any person violating this subsection shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. For numbers
18	violating this subsection shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. For purposes of this subsection,
19	"adult" shall mean a parent, guardian, person standing in loco parentis to the child or a person
20	twenty-one years or over who has the permission of the parent, guardian, or person standing in loco
21	parentis to supervise the child in the use of a firearm.
