A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.650 and 58.1-3650.651, designating certain organizations to be exempt from property taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.650 and 58.1-3650.651 as follows:
 - § 58.1-3650.650. Property of Bruton Park Home, Inc.
- A. Bruton Park Home, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
- B. Property located at 23 Courtney Avenue in the City of Newport News, owned by Bruton Park Home, Inc., and used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
 - § 58.1-3650.651. Property of Colony Pines Residents' Association, Inc.
- A. Colony Pines Residents' Association, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
- B. Property located at 12901 Woodside Lane in the City of Newport News, owned by Colony Pines Residents' Association, Inc., and used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
