10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 2.1-345 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 2.1-345. Public bodies to which chapter inapplicable.
13	The provisions of this chapter shall not be applicable to the Virginia Parole Board, petit juries, grand
14	juries, family assessment and planning teams established pursuant to § 2.1-753, and the Virginia State
15	Crime Commission. However, information from the Virginia Parole Board providing the number of
16	inmates considered by the Parole Board for discretionary parole, the number of inmates granted or
17	denied parole, and the number of parolees returned to the custody of the Department of Corrections
18	solely as a result of a determination by the Board of a violation of parole, shall be open to inspection
19	and releasable, on a monthly basis, as provided in § 2.1-342. Such information shall be furnished by
20	offense eategories, sex, race and , age of the inmates, and the locality in which the conviction was
21	obtained, upon the request of the party seeking the information.
