## HOUSE BILL NO. 76

Offered January 10, 1996

*A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 58.1-3650.650, designating certain organizations to be exempt from property taxation.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 58.1-3650.650 as follows:**

*§ 58.1-3650.650. Property of Serenity House Substance Abuse Recovery Program, Inc.*

*A. Serenity House Substance Abuse Recovery Program, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.*

*B. Property located on Richneck Road in Newport News, owned by Serenity House Substance Abuse Recovery Program, Inc., and used by it exclusively for benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.*
