A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-461 of the Code of Virginia, relating to giving false information to police officers; penalty.

Patrons—Woodrum, Cranwell and Thomas

Referred to Committee on Militia and Police

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 18.2-461 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 18.2-461. Giving false information or reports to police officers.

It shall be unlawful for any person knowingly to give a false report as to the commission of any crime to any law-enforcement official with intent to mislead. *It shall be unlawful for any arrestee knowingly to give a false name, date of birth, address, identification card or identification number to an arresting officer with intent to conceal his identity.* Violation of the provisions of this section shall be punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor.
