11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 58.1-3660.1 as follows:
13	§ 58.1-3660.1. Certified stormwater management developments and property.
14	A. Certified stormwater management developments and property, as defined herein, are hereby
15	declared to be a separate class of property and shall constitute a classification for local taxation
16	separate from other such classification of real property. The governing body of any county, city or town
17	may, by ordinance, exempt or partially exempt such property from local taxation.
18	B. As used in this section, "certified stormwater management developments and property" means any
19	real estate improvements which use permeable material to construct items such as, but not limited to,
20	roads, parking lots, patios, and driveways, which are otherwise constructed of impermeable materials,
21	and which the Department of Environmental Quality has certified to be designed, constructed, or
22	reconstructed for the primary purpose of abating or preventing pollution of the atmosphere or waters of
23	the Commonwealth by minimizing stormwater runoff. Permeable material shall be used for at least
24	seventy percent of the surface areas that would otherwise be covered by impermeable materials.
