11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 2.1-51.33 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 2.1-51.33. Subject to supervision by Governor; powers and duties.
13	A. The Secretary of Finance shall be subject to direction and supervision by the Governor.
14	The agencies assigned to the Secretary shall:
16	1. Exercise their respective powers and duties in accordance with the general policy established by
17	the Governor or by the Secretary acting on behalf of the Governor;
18	2. Provide such assistance to the Governor or the Secretary as may be required; and
10 19	3. Forward all reports to the Governor through the Secretary; and
20	4. To the greatest extent practicable, pay all amounts due and owing by the Commonwealth through

<sup>21</sup> 22	electronic transfers of funds from the general fund or appropriate special fund to the account or accounts designated by the payee. [ All wire transfer costs associated with the electronic transfer shall
23 24	be paid by the payee. ]
24 25	B. Unless the Governor expressly reserves such power to himself, the Secretary is empowered to:
	1. Resolve administrative, jurisdictional, operational, program, or policy conflicts between agencies or
26	officials assigned;
27	2. Direct the formulation of a comprehensive program budget for the functional area identified in
28	§ 2.1-398 encompassing the services of the agencies assigned for consideration by the Governor;
29	3. Hold agency heads accountable for their administrative, fiscal and program actions in the conduct
30	of the respective powers and duties of the agencies;
31	4. Direct the development of goals, objectives, policies and plans that are necessary to the effective
32	and efficient operation of government;
33 34	5. Sign documents on behalf of the Governor which originate with agencies assigned to the
