HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 95

Commending Thomas Jones.

WHEREAS, on December 9, 1995, Thomas Jones played his final football game in the uniform of Powell Valley High School; and

WHEREAS, in typical fashion, Thomas Jones made his last appearance memorable, setting a new state record for career touchdowns while leading his team to its second consecutive state championship; and

WHEREAS, throughout his career, Thomas Jones, a running back for the Vikings of Powell Valley, has set records, run roughshod over his opponents and led his team to victory; and

WHEREAS, in 1994, Thomas Jones set a new state record for most rushing yards in a season, running for an astonishing total of 3,319 yards; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Jones continued his assault on the record books in 1995, setting new marks for touchdowns in a season (49) and in a career (104); and

WHEREAS, named Virginia's Player of the Year, Thomas Jones gladdened the hearts of Virginia football fans when he announced his plans to attend the University of Virginia next year; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly commend Thomas Jones on the completion of a truly extraordinary high school football career; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to Thomas Jones in recognition of his superlative performance on the playing fields of Southwest Virginia.
