6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-309 of the Code of Virginia, relating to furnishing weapons to
7	minors; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 18.2-309 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 18.2-309. Furnishing certain weapons to minors; penalty.
11	A. If any person sells, barters, gives or furnishes, or causes to be sold, bartered, given or furnished,
12	to any minor a dirk, switchblade knife or bowie knife, having good cause to believe him to be a minor,
13	such person shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
14	B. If any person sells, barters, gives or furnishes, or causes to be sold, bartered, given or furnished,
15	to any minor a handgun, having good cause to believe him to be a minor, such person shall be guilty of
16	a Class 6 felony.
17	C. If any person sells or barters, or causes to be sold or bartered a handgun to a person he knows
18	
	is a minor, he shall be guilty of a Class 6 felony and upon conviction, shall be sentenced to a minimum,
19	mandatory term of confinement of one year, which shall not be suspended.
20	D This subsection Subsections B and C shall not apply to any transfer made between family members
21	or for the purpose of engaging in a sporting event or activity.
22	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment in state
23	correctional facilities. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation
24	for this bill as introduced was \$53,940.
