SENATE BILL NO. 204

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the House Committee on Transportation
on February 20, 1996)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Waddell)

A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 46.2-725, 46.2-742, and 46.2-749.2:1 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 46.2-749.2:2, 46.2-749.2:3, 46.2-749.2:4, and 46.2-749.2:5, relating to special license plates; fees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That §§ 46.2-725, 46.2-742, and 46.2-749.2:1 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 46.2-749.2:2, 46.2-749.2:3, 46.2-749.2:4, and 46.2-749.2:5 as follows:

§ 46.2-725. Special license plates, generally.

A. No series of special license plates shall be created or issued by the Commissioner or the Department except as authorized in this article. No special license plates in any series not provided for in this article and no registration decal for any such license plate shall be issued, reissued, or renewed on or after July 1, 1995. However, subject to the limitations contained in subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of this section, the Commissioner may issue special license plates that are combinations of no more than two series of special license plates authorized in this article; the fee for any such combination shall be equal to the sum of the fees for the two series plus the fee for reserved numbers and letters, if applicable. *The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of this section shall not apply to special license plates that are combinations of two series of special license plates authorized in this article if one of the two combined designs incorporates or includes the international symbol of access.*

B. Except as otherwise provided in this article:

1. No license plates provided for in this article shall be issued until the Commissioner receives at least 350 prepaid applications therefor;

2. No additional license plates shall be issued or reissued in any series that, after five or more years of issuance, has fewer than 100 active sets of plates, unless applications therefor again meet the criterion of subdivision 1 of this subsection;

3. All reissued or replacement special license plates shall be subject to a fee of fifteen dollars;

4. The annual fee for the issuance of any license plates issued pursuant to this article shall be ten dollars plus the prescribed fee for state license plates. Applications for all special license plates issued pursuant to this article shall be on forms prescribed by the Commissioner. All special license plates issued pursuant to this article shall be of designs prescribed by the Commissioner and shall bear unique letters and numerals, clearly distinguishable from any other license plate designs, and be readily identifiable by law-enforcement personnel.

No other state license plates shall be required on any vehicles bearing special license plates issued under the provisions of this article.

All fees collected by the Department under this article shall be paid by the Commissioner into the state treasury and shall be set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the expenses of the Department.

§ 46.2-742. Special license plates for persons awarded Purple Heart; fee.

On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded the Purple Heart, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are issued.

Unmarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section may also be issued special license plates under this section.

The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.

§ 46.2-749.2:1. Special license plates for supporters of certain children's programs; fees.

On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates bearing, at the applicant's option, either (i) a heart, (ii) a five-pointed star, or (iii) a child's handprint, or (iv) another design or device approved by the Commissioner.

The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars plus the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to the special fund known as the Children's Programs Support Fund for use as follows: one-half shall be

60 paid into the Family and Children's Trust Fund and one-half shall be paid to the Department of Health
61 for use by the Safe Kids Coalition.

62 § 46.2-749.2:2. Special license plates for supporters of Virginia state parks; fees.

63 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner
64 shall issue special license plates bearing the following legend: VIRGINIA STATE PARKS.

65 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to
66 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of
67 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and paid
68 annually to the Virginia State Parks Foundation to be used in support of the Foundation's activities and
69 programs.

70 § 46.2-749.2:3. Special license plates for supporters of the 4-H Foundation; fees.

71 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner
72 shall issue special license plates to supporters of the 4-H Foundation.

73 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to
74 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of
75 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and paid
76 annually to the 4-H Foundation to be used to offer 4-H educational opportunities to youth throughout
77 the Commonwealth.

78 § 46.2-749.2:4. Special license plates for supporters of dog and cat sterilization programs; fees.

79 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner
80 shall issue special license plates to supporters of dog and cat sterilization programs.

81 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to
82 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of
83 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid to the locality in which the
84 vehicle is registered. These funds shall be paid to the affected localities quarterly and shall be used by
85 the localities to which they are paid to support sterilization programs for dogs and cats.

86 Each affected locality shall annually certify in a manner prescribed by the Commissioner that these
87 funds have been or are being used to support sterilization programs for dogs and cats. If an affected
88 locality does not have such a sterilization program, it shall (i) make the funds available to a private,
89 nonprofit sterilization program for dogs and cats in that locality, (ii) return the funds to the
90 Commissioner; or (iii) refuse the funds. Any funds refused, returned to the Commissioner, or otherwise
91 not paid to an affected locality shall be distributed to other affected localities on a pro rata basis.

92 § 46.2-749.2:5. Special license plates for supporters of Virginians for the Arts; fees.

93 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner
94 shall issue special license plates bearing the following legend: VIRGINIANS FOR THE ARTS.

95 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to
96 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of
97 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and
98 credited to the special nonreverting fund known as the Virginians for the Arts Fund, established within
99 the Department of Accounts, for use by the Virginians for the Arts organization to support the arts in
100 the Commonwealth.
