A BILL to amend and reenact § 23-231.3 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Southwest Virginia
Higher Education Center.

Referred to the Committee on Rules
Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
1. That § 23-231.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
§ 23-231.3. Membership of governing board; terms; compensation; officers.
A. The Center shall be governed by a Board of Trustees, consisting of the Director of the State
Council of Higher Education for Virginia or his designee, the Chancellor of the Virginia Community
College System or his designee, the presidents or their designees of Virginia Polytechnic Institute and
State University, Radford University, the University of Virginia, Clinch Valley College, and Virginia
Highlands Community College, and five citizen members to be appointed by the Governor, representing
Southwest public education and area business and industry, including one school division superintendent
and one public school teacher. Five members of the General Assembly, including three members of the House of Delegates to be appointed by the Speaker and two members of the Senate to be appointed by
the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections, shall serve as ex officio members of the Board with
full voting privileges. Citizen members of the Board shall be chosen from among residents of the
Southwest region of the Commonwealth.
B. Legislative members and the representatives of the State Council, the Virginia Community College
System, and the named institutions of higher education shall serve on the Board until the expiration of
their terms of office or until their successors shall qualify. Of the five citizen members to be appointed
in 1991, two shall be appointed for three-year terms, and three shall be appointed for four-year terms.

Thereafter, all such citizen appointments shall be for terms of four years, except that appointments to fill 28 29 vacancies shall be for the unexpired terms.

No citizen member of the Board shall be eligible to serve for or during more than two successive 30 31 four-year terms, but after the expiration of a term of three years or less, or after the expiration of the 32 remainder of a term to which appointed to fill a vacancy, two additional four-year terms may be served 33 by such member if appointed thereto.

C. Legislative members of the Board shall be compensated as specified in § 14.1-18, and all members of the Board shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses incurred in the performance of their 34 35 36 duties in the work of the Center. 37

D. The Board shall elect a chairman and a vice chairman from among its members.

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
