9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 58.1-3818 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 58.1-3818. Admissions tax in certain counties.
12	A. Fairfax, Arlington, Dinwiddie, Loudoun [, Prince William] and Prince George Counties are
13	hereby authorized to levy a tax on admissions charged for attendance at any event. The tax shall not
14	exceed ten percent of the amount of charge for admission to any such event. Notwithstanding any other
15	
16	conditions and amount of such tax and may classify between events conducted for charitable and those

17 conducted for noncharitable purposes.

B. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection A of this section, any county with a population of at
least 27,500 but not more than 28,250 is hereby authorized to levy a tax on admission charged for
attendance at any event as set forth in subsection A.
