7 1. That Chapter 393 of the Acts of Assembly of 1932 is amended by adding a section numbered
8 22.4 as follows:

9 § 22.4. Additional powers; consolidation of sheriff's office.

10 The city council may, in concurrence with the board of supervisors of James City County, petition 11 the circuit court asking that a referendum be held in accordance with the provisions of § 15.1-40.2 of 12 the Code of Virginia on the question of whether the two localities may share the office of sheriff; 13 provided, rather than by a petition of qualified voters, the petition may be initiated by the two governing 14 bodies upon the written concurrence of the sheriffs of James City County and the City of Williamsburg

15 and following a public hearing and adoption by each governing body of a resolution in favor of the

16 consolidation of the two offices.
