10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-749.2:2 as follows:
12	§ 46.2-749.2:2. Special license plates for supporters of dog and cat sterilization programs; fees.
13	A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner
14 15	shall issue special license plates to supporters of dog and cat sterilization programs.
	B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to the prescribed for for state license plates. For each such twenty five dollar fee collected in graces of
16 17	the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of
18	1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid [to the locality in which the vehicle is registered. to the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known as the Dog
19	and Cat Sterilization Fund, established within the Department of Accounts.] These funds shall be paid
20	[to the affected localities quarterly annually to the locality in which the vehicle is registered] and shall
2 0 2 1	be used by the localities to which they are paid to support sterilization programs for dogs and cats.
22	Each affected locality shall annually certify in a manner prescribed by the [Commissioner Fund]
23	that these funds have been or are being used to support sterilization programs for dogs and cats. If an
24	affected locality does not have such a sterilization program, it shall (i) make the funds available to $\begin{bmatrix} a \\ a \end{bmatrix}$
25	any] private, nonprofit sterilization program for dogs and cats in that locality, (ii) return the funds to
26	the [Commissioner Fund]; or (iii) refuse the funds. Any funds refused or returned to the [
27	Commissioner Fund] shall be distributed to other affected localities on a pro rata basis.
