| 12 | the continuation of such nuisance, if found guilty, shall be fined, in the discretion of the jury, not more |
| 13 | than \$5,000 \$10,000; and upon such verdict the judgment of the court shall be for the amount of fine |
| 14 | imposed and the costs of such proceeding, and also that such nuisance be forthwith removed and abated. |

A party found guilty of contempt under the provisions of § 48-10, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 \$2,500, or by imprisonment in jail not less than three months nor more than six months, or in the discretion of the court by both fine and imprisonment. 16 17
