10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered § 6.1-2.16 as follows:
12	§ 6.1-2.16. Fiduciary obligations of settlement agents; registration; regulations.
13	A. In the performance of their duties, settlement agents shall act in accordance with the highest
14	standards of fiduciary conduct. Accordingly, such agents shall (i) avoid or promptly resolve conflicts of
15	interests, (ii) prevent improper influences from affecting their actions, and (iii) assure their compliance
16	with all applicable laws and regulations including such registration and financial responsibility
17	requirements as may be established by the Commission.
18	B. The Commission shall promulgate rules and regulations establishing annual registration and
19	financial responsibility requirements for all settlement agents. Such requirements may include the
20	submission of an initial registration and subsequent annual renewals thereof, payment of registration
21	fees and the furnishing of surety bonds, or other sufficient securities, in amounts satisfactory to the
22	Commission. In establishing such requirements, the Commission may exempt therefrom settlement agents
23	who are otherwise licensed pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 39 (§ 54.1-3900, et seq.) of Title 54.1.
24	Before promulgating any such rules or regulations, the Commission shall give reasonable notice of their
25	content and shall afford interested parties an opportunity to be heard, in accordance with the Rules of
26	Practice and Procedure of the Commission.
