## SENATE BILL NO. 71

Senate Amendments in [] — January 26, 1996

A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 58.1-3650.650, designating certain organizations to be exempt from property taxation.

## Referred to the Committee on Finance

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 58.1-3650.650 as follows:

§ 58.1-3650.650. Property of [Virginia] Peninsula Shelter for Abused Children, Inc., t/a Safehaven. A. [Virginia] Peninsula Shelter for Abused Children, Inc., t/a Safehaven, a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.

B. Property located at 12749 Nettles Drive in the City of Newport News, owned by [Virginia] Peninsula Shelter for Abused Children, Inc., t/a Safehaven, and used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
