The Senate shall consist of not more than forty and not less than thirty-three forty-one members, who shall be elected quadrennially by the voters of the several senatorial districts on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November. Section 3. House of Delegates. The House of Delegates shall consist of not more than one hundred and not less than ninety one hundred and one members, who shall be elected biennially by the voters of the several house districts on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November.
