Patron-Reasor 8 Referred to the Committee on Rules 9 10 WHEREAS, the Federal Surface Mining Act of 1977 has been adopted by the Commonwealth of 11 Virginia; and 12 WHEREAS, the current reclamation laws require complete elimination of all highwalls; and WHEREAS, this requirement discourages the use and economical re-mining of abandoned strip mine 13 14 sites in Southwest Virginia; and WHEREAS, the re-mining of such abandoned sites would increase employment and provide usable 15 16 reclaimed property for housing and industrial development; and 17 WHEREAS, the General Assembly of Virginia appreciates and supports reasonable safeguards to protect watersheds, streams, water supplies and citizens; and 18 WHEREAS, the General Assembly believes that government funds now being used to reclaim 19 20 abandoned sites should be substantially used to supply potable water to coalfield residents; [ now, 21 therefore, be it 22 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That and 23 WHEREAS, ] the Virginia General Assembly [ support supports ] the appropriate amendments to all 24 applicable federal and state laws and regulations which would encourage and allow the re-mining of 25 previously strip-mined sites under the appropriate safeguards to ensure protection of the public safety 26 and welfare; [ now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the Congress of the United 27 28 States be urged to support appropriate amendments to federal laws to encourage the re-mining of 29 previously strip-mined sites; ] and, be it RESOLVED [ FINALLY FURTHER ], That the Clerk of the Senate transmit copies of this
