SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 9

Designating March 17-23, 1996, as Free Enterprise Week in Franklin County.

Agreed to by the Senate, March 6, 1996

WHEREAS, the American free enterprise system forms the very basis of the economic prosperity of the United States and the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, promoting the free enterprise system contributes to Virginia's successful economic development efforts and to the continued economic health of the Commonwealth; and

RESOLVED by the Senate, That the week of March 17-23, 1996, be designated as Free Enterprise Week in Franklin County; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to the Ferrum College Chapter of Students in Free Enterprise in honor of its worthy and successful efforts to promote the free enterprise system.
