An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-726 of the Code of Virginia, relating to license plates; fees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 46.2-726 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-726. License plates with reserved numbers or letters; fees.

The Commissioner may, in his discretion, reserve license plates with certain registration numbers or letters or combinations thereof for issuance to persons requesting license plates so numbered and lettered.

License plates with reserved numbers or letters may be issued for and displayed on vehicles operated as ambulances by private ambulance services.

The annual fee for the issuance of any license plates with reserved numbers or letters shall be ten dollars plus the prescribed fee for state license plates. If those license plates with reserved numbers or letters are subject to an additional fee beyond the prescribed fee for state license plates, the fee for such special license plates with reserved numbers or letters shall be ten dollars plus the additional fee for the special license plates plates plates plates plates plates be the special license plates plates

The annual fee for reissuing license plates with the same combination of letters and numbers as license plates that were previously issued but not renewed shall be ten dollars plus the prescribed fee for state license plates. If those license plates are special license plates subject to an additional fee beyond the prescribed fee for state license plates, the fee shall be ten dollars plus the additional fee for the special license plates plates plus the prescribed fee for state license plates.
